



ADOPTION STATEMENT

This Adoption statement has been prepared in accordance with Regulation 19 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Development) (England) Regulations 2004 and gives notice that Ashford Borough Council has formally adopted its Residential Parking Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) on the 21st October 2010.

The SPD sets out the Council's proposed residential parking standards for different parts of the Borough and provides guidance on different types of parking and how they may be designed into different characters of urban environment. The SPD is the first of its type in Kent to take forward the standards and place-making principles established in KCC's Interim Guidance Note 3 (2008) and interpret them in a local context.

Public consultation on the contents of the emerging SPD was carried out between 1st July and 13th August 2010, and resulted in 32 representations being received. Respondents included national and local housebuilding companies, local Parish Councils, the Highways and Environment Agencies as well as Kent County Council.

Any person with sufficient interest in the Council's decision to adopt the SPD may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of that decision. Any such application must be made promptly and in any event no later than 3 months after the date of adoption specified above.
