(AMENDMENT No. 14) ORDER 2010
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

NOTICE is hereby given that the Kent County Council, in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2 and 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers, has made an Order the purpose of which is to amend 'The Kent County Council (Various Roads, Borough of Ashford) Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) Consolidation Order 2007' as amended, the effect of which will be:

To introduce new and amended 'no waiting at anytime' restrictions in the following roads in Tenterden; **Appledore Road, Beacon Oak Road, East Hill, Golden Square**. These changes are intended to address current unsafe parking practices and provide additional parking where safe to do so.

Anyone may, by application to the High Court within 6 weeks of the date of publication of this Notice, challenge the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or of any instrument made thereunder, or that there has been a failure to comply with any statutory requirement in relation to the Order.
