(AMENDMENT No. 16) ORDER 2010
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

NOTICE is hereby given that the Kent County Council, in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 4, 32, 35, 45, 46, 47 and 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers, proposes to make an Order the effect of which will be to amend 'The Kent County Council (Various Roads, Borough of Ashford) Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) Consolidation Order 2007' as amended, the effect of which will be:

- 1) To make various administrative changes to the current On-Street Traffic Order relating to descriptions of restrictions in roads within Ashford town centre.
- 2) To amend waiting and parking restrictions within East Street, Ashford in order to reflect physical changes to the road layout resulting from the new Latitude Walk development.
- 3) To extend 'no waiting at any time' restrictions in Gasworks Lane, Ashford to protect access to the railway line.
- 4) To make minor adjustments to the location of Pay & Display and Loading bays in Godinton Road, Ashford to improve sight lines at accesses and junctions.
