ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

NOTICE is hereby given that the Kent County Council, in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2 and 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers, proposes to make an Order the effect of which will be to amend 'The Kent County Council (Various Roads, Borough of Ashford) Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) Consolidation Order 2007'.

The new Order will have the effect as to alter current restrictions and introduce new parking restrictions in the Ashford Area as detailed in the Schedule below:
