

**THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL
(VARIOUS ROADS, BOROUGH OF ASHFORD)
(WAITING RESTRICTIONS AND STREET PARKING PLACES)
(AMENDMENT NO. 9) ORDER 2009
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

NOTICE is hereby given that the Kent County Council, in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2 and 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the said Act, has made an Order the purpose of which is to make administrative changes to the current on-street parking Order.

The new Order does not propose to implement any new waiting restrictions or street parking places or amend the location or extent of any existing restrictions or parking places.

A copy of the Order may be inspected during normal office hours at the offices of Ashford Borough Council, Civic Centre, Tannery Lane, Ashford, Kent TN23 1PL. A copy will also be available at the main reception of Invicta House, Maidstone, Kent ME14 1XX. The order can also be viewed at www.ashford.gov.uk.

Anyone may, by application to the High Court within 6 weeks of the date of publication of this Notice, challenge the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or of any instrument made thereunder, or that there has been a failure to comply with any statutory requirement in relation to the Order.
