

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1984

The Ashford Borough Council (hereinafter referred to as “the Council”) in exercise of their powers under Section 35C of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (hereinafter referred to as “the Act”) and in accordance with the regulations made by the Secretary of State (The Local Authorities’ Traffic Orders (Procedure)(England and Wales)) Regulations Act 1996 and of all other enabling powers hereby give notice that the charges be paid in connection with the off-street parking places will, from 29th April 2010, be varied as follows –

Daily Car Parking Charges (vehicles under 3.5 tonnes gross laden weight)

Daily charge for Civic Centre & Stour Centre car park is up to 2 hours 60p. Between 2 – 4 hours 90p per hour payable in 5p (3.33 minutes) increments. Over 4 hours; Mondays to Fridays £10.00, Saturdays and Sundays £4.50.

Daily charge for Dover Place, Edinburgh Road and Station Road (Ashford) car parks is 90p per hour payable in 5p (3.33 minutes) increments. Minimum payment is 30p (20 minutes). Over 4 hours £4.50

Daily charge for Flour Mills and Henwood car parks is 90p per hour payable in 5p (3.33 minutes) increments. Minimum payment is 30p (20 minutes). Over 4 hours £3.60.

Daily charge for Vicarage Lane car park is 90p per hour payable in 5p (3.33 minutes) increments. Minimum payment is 30p (20 minutes). Over 4 hours £10.00.

Daily charge for Bridewell Lane car park is 80p per hour payable in 5p (3.75 minutes) increments. Minimum payment is 30p (23 minutes). Over 4 hours £4.00.

Daily charge for Station Road (East & West) (Tenterden), Recreation Ground Road, and Tenterden Leisure Centre car parks is 80p per hour payable in 5p (3.75 minutes) increments. Minimum payment is 30p (23 minutes). Over 4 hours £10.00.

Daily Coach Parking Charges

Daily charge for Civic Centre & Stour Centre, Henwood, Station Road (East) (Tenterden), and Tenterden Leisure Centre car parks is £1.30 per hour payable in 5p (2.31 minutes) increments. Minimum payment is £1.30 (1 hour). Over 4 hours £10.00.

Daily Car Parking Charges (vehicles between 3.5 tonnes and 26 tonnes gross laden weight – excluding coaches)

Daily charge for Henwood car park is £1.30 per hour payable in 5p (2.31 minutes) increments. Minimum payment is £1.30 (1 hour). Over 4 hours £10.00.

Season Ticket Charges

Unreserved season ticket charges for Edinburgh Road, Dover Place, and Station Road (Ashford) car parks are as follows; 1 month £76, 3 months £215, 6 months £405, 12 months £760. Season tickets are interchangeable between the above car parks. Season tickets are not valid in Edinburgh Road car park on Sundays.

Reserved season ticket charges for Edinburgh Road car park are 12 months £1520. These season tickets are only valid Monday to Friday.

Unreserved season ticket charges for Flour Mills car park are as follows; 1 month £61, 3 months £173, 6 months £325, 12 months £610.

Unreserved season ticket charges for Bridewell Lane and Tenterden Leisure Centre (rear) car parks are as follows; 1 month £68, 3 months £191, 6 months £360, 12 months £675.

Reserved season ticket charges for Bridewell Lane are 12 months £1350.

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Notice or of its provisions on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the relevant enabling Act or that a requirement of any such enabling Act or of any relevant regulations made thereunder has not been complied with may, within 6 weeks from the date on which the Notice was published, make application for the purpose to the High Court.
