

Some of the limitations on temporary event notices are as follows:

Events are limited to 499 people at any one time.

No more than 15 applications at any venue in any one calendar year (this was increased from 12 on 1 January 2016).

A temporary event can last for no more than 168 hours and the premises is limited to a maximum of 21 days in any one calendar year.

There must be at least 24 hours between events.

Anyone aged 18 or over can give a maximum of five temporary event notices per year.

Personal licence holders can give a maximum of 50 temporary event notices per year.

There must be a minimum of 24 hours between events notified by a premises user or associates of that premises user in respect of the same premises.
