Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

Notice is given that THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL acting as the Local Traffic Authority and in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 32, 35, 36, 45, 46, 47, 49, 53, 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ('the Act'), the Traffic Management Act 2004 and all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby proposed to make the following Order:-

The effect of the made Order will be to introduce a Permit Parking Area in Park Place and the formalisation of disabled persons parking bays across the borough.

Roads in the Borough of Ashford

Park Place – Introduction of a Permit Parking Area in the entirety of Park Place. Properties 1-32 Park Place would be eligible for a permit under the scheme.

Park Place – Introduction of 97.7m of double yellow lines.

Christchurch Road – Introduction of a 6.6m disabled persons parking bay outside number 96.

Francis Road – Introduction of a 6.6m disabled persons parking bay outside number 22.

Sussex Avenue – Introduction of a 6.6m disabled persons parking bay outside number 33.

Summer Leeze – introduction of a 6.6m disabled persons parking bay outside number 38.

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

The Kent County Council, acting as the Local Traffic Authority and in exercise of its powers and under Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 19, 32, 35, 36, 45, 46, 49, 51, 53, 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ('the Act') and all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby propose to make the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on the day of 2026 and may be cited as "The Kent County Council (Various Roads, Ashford) (Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2023 (Amendment No.28) Order 2026" ("this Order")
2. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply to this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, "The Kent County Council (Various Roads, Ashford) (Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2023" ("the Order of 2023") shall have effect as though:
 - a) Schedule 2 to the Order of 2023 is amended by the replacement or issue of the following Map Tiles:

EY122 revision 1 replaced by	EY122 revision 2
EW122 revision 3 replaced by	EW122 revision 4
EX122 revision 3 replaced by	EX122 revision 4
ER122 revision 2 replaced by	ER122 revision 3
EX125 revision 1 replaced by	EX125 revision 2
