6. Your Comments

Please state fully and clearly below the grounds of your objection or support, or whether you consider there to be an omission from the plan:

There is a large area lying between the areas designated as views V4 and V5. We respectfully request that this area should also be a designated area for the purposes of policy R2.

This area is in the shape of an inverted triangle and lies to the south of the residences on the south side of Lambden Road. These residences include our residence, Jonleigh. This area is visible from those residences, from 2 public footpaths which run at the side of or across the area and, to some extent, from Smarden Road.

This area is deserving of designation as it is, no less than areas V4 and V5, an area of tranquil, visual amenity which is home to fields, mature oak and other trees and hedgerows and is a habitat for wildlife. Its current uses include agriculture and in part for stabling and exercising horses.

When we raised our concerns with the Parish Council on the occasion of the pre-submission of the Neighbourhood Plan, the Parish Council said "...no-one has a right to a view, it is not a planning consideration..." With respect to the Parish Council, we are not claiming a right to a view. What we are requesting is that this area should enjoy the protection afforded to, amongst others, areas V4 and V5, namely,

"Development that significantly detracts from these views (shown in Map 3) by failing to respect their distinctive characteristics, will not be supported unless they are required for a statutory utility infrastructure project."
