Notice is hereby given that Ashford Borough Council (the Council") in exercise of its powers under sections 32, 33, 35, 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 ("the 1984 act") and section 43 and schedule 3 of the Road Traffic Act ("the 1991 Act") Part 6 of the Traffic Management Act 2004 ("the 2004 Act") and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf and with the consent of the Kent County Council given under section 30(3) of the 1984 Act and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of schedule 9 to the 1984 Act hereby intend to make the following Order:-

The effect of the made Order will be to introduce new car park locations in the borough of Ashford.

Ellingham Car Park A – A mixture of permit holders only and 23-hour time limited parking bays

Ellingham Car Park B - Permit holders only
