THIS DEED OF VARIATION dated

27 May 2011 is made between:

- (1) **SOUTH EAST ENGLAND DEVELOPMENT AGENCY** (a body corporate under the Regional Development Agencies Act 1998) of Cross Lanes, Guildford GU1 1YN ("the **Agency**")
- (2) **ASHFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL** of Civic Centre, Tannery Lane, Ashford TN23 1PL ("ABC")
- (3) THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL of County Hall, Maidstone, Kent, ME14 1XQ ("KCC")

BACKGROUND

- 1. This Deed is supplemental to a Regional Infrastructure Fund Funding Agreement dated 4th May 2010 in respect of Improvements to Junction 9 of the M20 together with provision of a new footbridge at Ashford, Kent ("the **Agreement**") and terms defined in the Agreement have the same meanings in this Deed.
- 2. The Works are in progress and in the light of the progress thereof the Parties have agreed to increase the available Funding by £1,500,000 and to extend the period in which the Funding must be spent and to otherwise alter the Agreement on the terms set out in this Deed.
- 3. The Parties acknowledge that this variation arises from a Material Change and that KCC has complied with the requirements of clause 7.2 of the Agreement in respect of such Material Change.

VARIATIONS TO THE AGREEMENT

1. It having been decided to increase the available Funding by £1,500,000 in accordance with this Deed and it having previously been determined that the Works shall include the Pedestrian and Cycle landmark bridge, the definition of "Maximum Sum" in paragraph 3 of Schedule 3 to the Agreement shall be amended to read as follows:

"The Maximum Sum to be provided under this Agreement is £9,600,000."

- 2. With reference to Recital (I) of the Agreement, the Parties hereby:
 - (a) agree that the deadline for expenditure therein referred to as 31 March 2011 shall be extended to 30 June 2011; and
 - (b) confirm that the Department for Transport has agreed to the increase in available Funding referred to in clause 1 of this Deed.
- Schedule 4 to the Agreement shall be amended as shown by the text struck through and inserted in the copy of Schedule 4 attached at Appendix A to this Deed.
- 4. In all other respects the Agreement remains in full force and effect.
- 5. This Deed may be executed in any number of counterparts and each counterpart shall, when executed be an original of this Deed and all counterparts together shall constitute one instrument.
