The Ashford Borough Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of its powers under Section 32, 33 35, 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984,(hereinafter referred to as "the Act"), and section 43 and Schedule 3 of the Roads Traffic Act 1991 ("the 1991 Act") Part 6 of the Traffic Management Act 2004 ("the 2004 Act") and of all other enabling powers, and with the consent of the Kent County Council given under section 39(3) of the Act and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act, hereby proposes to make the following Order:-

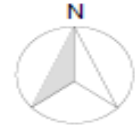
