In response to your e-mail request dated 19th March below please now find attached copies of the documents summarising the Questions and Answers attended to as part of the Regulation 14 consultation-

Each of the adjoining Parish Councils were invited by e-mail to respond to the Draft Plan but no responses were received- (ref Page 33)

A Business survey was carried out via "Survey Monkey" questionnaire by the Blue Group but too few responses were received to be significant.

Utilities in general were not formally invited to comment, but much parallel work to the Neighbourhood Plan was conducted by PC with Southern Water, Kent Highways, and the Environment Agency to promote improvement to both the surface water and foul water drainage network serving the village and of general concern to the community.
