2. JC White Survey of the buildings December 2015 full listed complex

Electronic survey provided to CAT to prepare drawings of all buildings and to prepare a commentary on built heritage and archaeology to inform the discussion of the design of the proposals March 2016 ahead of further discussions with HE in March 16. Preliminary Historic Buildings Assessment commenced
5. Further site meeting with HE on 30 March 2016
6. Hobbs Parker pre app to ABC 21 July 2016
